### **System Requirements**

We recommend that your computer system have the following minimum specifications to guarantee proper operation of CAPA Facilitator.

Computer:                Intel® Pentium II 400MHz processor or equivalent  
                              256Mb RAM  
                              10Mb of free HDD space

Operating system:    Windows® 98, ME, NT, 2000 or XP  
                              Microsoft .NET Framework v1.1 (*Note: If the .Net Framework is not currently available on your computer, it will be installed during the CAPA Facilitator installation.*)

### **Installation Instructions**

All necessary files to install the software, training and guidelines are provided on the CD.

1. Insert the CAPA Facilitator CD into the CD/DVD drive of your computer. On the Windows “Start” menu, click “Run” and type in x:\setup where “x” is the letter of your CD/DVD drive. **(or)** Using Windows Explorer, double click on the CD/DVD drive, and double click on “Setup.exe.” A Windows Security Warning dialog box may appear indicating that “the publisher could not be verified,” choose “Run” to continue installing the software.
2. The setup wizard will run and a **CAPA Facilitator Setup Wizard** dialog box will appear. To start the CAPA Facilitator setup Click “Next.” Click “Cancel” if you would like to quit without installing the software.
3. A **Customer Information** dialog box will appear. Enter your name and organization (optional.) Choose “Next.”
4. The **Select Installation Folder** dialog box will appear which, allows choosing a destination for the CAPA Facilitator files other than the default. The default directory is C:\Program Files\CAPAFacPro. Use “Browse” to choose a different destination directory
